Newsletter 1- 9th September, 2022

I hope you all had a good summer break. It's been great to welcome several new pupils to our schools and Mrs Roberts- Lilley to our staff this term and to see the children settling quickly into routines this week and producing some good work. We had an exciting first day back, with Rookhope watching the Tour of Britain at Eastgate and the other two schools watching the tour in St John's Chapel. I thought it would be useful at the start of term to provide a quick update of what's happening across the federation.

Our learning this term



Our EYFS/KS1 theme this term is 'School Days'. In the School Days project, your child will have the opportunity to take part in a traditional Victorian class and will learn about the differences between schooling in the Victorian era and schooling today. They will learn about objects found in a Victorian classroom and how they were used. The Y2 pupils will research Samuel Wilderspin, an important figure in the development of schooling for young children in the Victorian era, whose

ideals are reflected in schooling today. They will learn to describe the passage of time through study of past, present and future tense vocabulary. We hope to visit Beamish museum school later this term to enhance this project.

Our KS2 theme this term is 'Dynamic Dynasties'

In Dynamic Dynasties, your child will learn about periods of ancient Chinese history. They will explore a timeline of the first five Chinese dynasties and learn about the legends surrounding the beginning of Chinese civilisation. They will



take a deep dive into the history of the Bronze Age Shang Dynasty and explore evidence found in the ancient city of Yin. They will study oracle bones, learn about religious beliefs and explore bronze artefacts that set the Shang Dynasty apart from other civilisations. They will also study the hierarchy of the Shang Dynasty and discover who was powerful and who was powerless. They will look at warfare and find out how bronze technology gave the Shang Dynasty an advantage over their enemies. They will learn about the life of the great military leader, Fu Hao. The children will then look at significant aspects of life after the Shang Dynasty, including the work of Confucius in the Zhou Dynasty, the short but significant reign of Emperor Qin Shi Huang of the Qin Dynasty and the importance of the Silk Road created by the Han Dynasty. To end the project, your child will find out how ancient China's lasting legacy can be seen in the world today.

Lunch money

As we currently have only one administrator working across the federation, we have had to make a few changes to our administrative procedures. Lunch money is now £2-25 per day for KS2 pupils and £2-70 for preschool pupils. Please send monies in an envelope that is clearly labelled with your child's name and what the money is for. Cheques should be made payable to *Durham County Council*. If you wish to pay for the half-term, the cost is £76-50 for KS2 pupils.
